In doing this He offered His disciples a profound and radically counter-cultural demonstration of the very heart of God. The towel is more than a symbol at Taylor. It is a tangible expression of the mission of the University, reminding and challenging graduates that all they have and will accomplish of real significance comes by participating in the servant ministry of Jesus Christ-both in them and in the world.

The Taylor towel is a simple physical reminder of the emphasis placed throughout the Taylor experience on serving one another in love in reflection of God's love for us. The towel clarifies the ideals and aspirations for Christian community expressed in our Life Together Covenant, announcing our calling to a persevering love, the kind that seeks to foster wholly integrated followers of Christ in a community where brokenness is being redeemed.
