

## 2022-2023 Standard Verification Worksheet Independent Student

You must complete and sign this institutional verification document, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to our office. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
