

Kids' Chance Scholarship Overview

Background:

Kids' Chance of Indiana is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides scholarships for children of workers that have been killed or seriously injured in a compensable work-related accident or occupational disease. Scholarships are awarded once a year and students may apply every year for which they are eligible. Annual scholarships are determined based on the student's financial need. The number and amount of scholarships awarded by Kids' Chance of Indiana each year is dependent upon the number and eligibility of students who apply and the available funds.

	Demonstrated financial need to pay for post-secondary education.			
	Accepted or already enrolled at a [university, college or technical school]. (Graduate-level students are not eligible.)			
	Completion of the FAFSA – the Free Application for Federal Student Aid – for students attending a 2-year or 4-year college or university.			
	The Indiana Worker's Compensation Board has issued an Award or approved an Agreement to Compensation finding that the related accident was compensable under the Indiana Worker's Compensation Act.
